I John 4:7 (NIV) Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

I John 3:14 (NIV) We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love each other. Anyone who does not love remains in death.

I John 3:10 (NIV) This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are: Anyone who does not do what is right is not God's child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother and sister.

I John 4:8 (NIV) Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.

I John 2:9-10 (NIV) ⁹ Anyone who claims to be in the light but hates a brother or sister is still in the darkness. ¹⁰ Anyone who loves their brother and sister lives in the light, and there is nothing in them to make them stumble.

II John 1:5 (NLT) I am writing to remind you, dear friends, that we should love one another. This is not **a new commandment**, but one we have had from the beginning.
