Ephesians 5:25-26 (ESV)

²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, ²⁶ that he might sanctify her,

Charge:

"Husbands, Love her – as Christ loved the church. Giving up all that he had, for the purpose of HER sanctification... presentation to the Father as a pure and spotless bride.

Ephesians 5:22-24 (ESV)

²² Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. ²³ For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. 24 Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.

Charge:
