

John 3 pt II

vs16-17 - condemn - judge/destroy/hurt/shame/harm/ignore/push to the side

saved - rescue/remove from sin and shame/bless/restore

vs18-19 - people without Christ are already condemned

v19 - choice/surrender

\*Jesus has chosen us---surrender to His choice

light came - people chose darkness and religion

v20 - people hate the light because of what it reveals

v21 - salvation is all from God

vs22-26 - people were coming to Jesus and disciples of J the B were upset

v27 - God the Father is giving the people to Jesus

\*God is the source of everything we have - Dt 8:6-20

vs28-30 - The Bridegroom is Jesus Christ

-The Bride is the church

-Friend of the Bridegroom is John the Baptist

-they get everything ready for the bridegroom to appear/take care of him

v30 - I must go to the background and Jesus needs to be at the forefront

v31 - Jesus is above all and from above

-everyone else is earthy

v32 - few make it to heaven - Matthew 7:13-14

v33 - is true - genuine and real

vs34-35 - Jesus has the Holy Spirit without measure

\*GIVE - speaks of a continuous and uninterrupted flow of the Holy Spirit

John 4

Samaria

vs1-4 - I must go through Samaria

\*\*\*Samaria was located between Judea and Galilee

\*the people were a mixed race - part Jewish and part gentile

vs5-6 - this was noon

Jacob's well was located here

WELLS - spoke of provision/health/prosperity/the Word of God

The WELLS of Isaac in Genesis 26:14-33

v17 - Isaac comes to Gerar - means to drag off

-God drags us to a lot of places

-this also represents staying in one place for a long period of time

v18 - Isaac dug up the wells his dad had already dug - Abraham

-his dad's doctrine and words of wisdom were worth keeping

-the well and its water represents the Word of God

vs19-21 - Esek means to quarrel  
-Sitnah means strife

-people get offended when you dig a well and teach the Word of God

John 6:47-69

v22 - Rehoboth means wide places---spaciousness---plenty of room

-it is a place of more

vs23-25 - Beersheba - means well of oath  
The Lord makes an oath with us that if we drink of Him, He will show up

John 4:7 - whoever comes our way is an appointment from God  
\*Jesus reached out to her

\*the woman was just looking for regular water

vs8-10 - If you knew 2 things:

(1) who it is you are talking to - the Messiah/God almighty

(2) the gift of God  
-this is Jesus Christ Himself

-Jesus is a gift and gives gifts - ask Him - Matthew 7:7-8

-living water - is flowing all of the time  
-constantly ask and constantly receive

vs11-12 - there are no containers to place the water in

v13 - the water in the well will never quench your thirst long term

v14 - the water Jesus gives you quenches your thirst forever

-it then flows out of us - to touch others

\*you can tell who has been drinking - this living water
