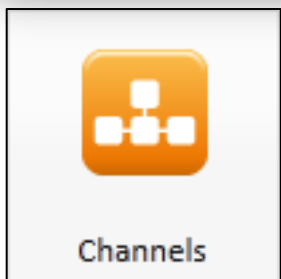

Located in the **MODULES** portion of the **CONTENT** section of the Channels Page, the Channel Wide – Call to Action (CTA) feature allows you to display custom content in the Media Center’s player window. The display can be turned **ON** or **OFF** & Edited within the Media Center in real-time, without the viewer needing to refresh their screen.

To activate the CTA, use the **SAVE** command at the top of the page with the CTA display set to **On**.

Then modify the content within the **WYSIWYG** Editor and press the “save/disk” icon in the Editor, and the change to automatically reveal itself within your Media Center.

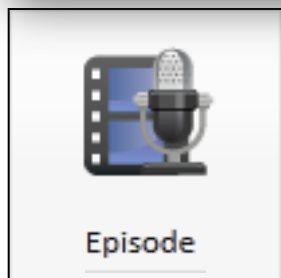
